Aims & Scope and Publication Policy

REFLECTION: UGB JOURNAL OF PHILOSOPHY is an annual and peer-reviewed/refereed journal of the Department of Philosophy, University of Gour Banga, Malda, India. It is devoted to the publication of original papers of high standards in any branch of philosophy. The Journal enhances the scope of teaching-learning process, promotes creative innovation and research in specific philosophical problems connected with their respective fields of specialization. The editorial board is committed to keep the quality of the journal. Articles, reviews, critical discussions that are not published elsewhere will be considered for publication in this journal after blind review and upon the acceptance after positive comments from the reviewers.

Note to the Authors

REFLECTION: UGB JOURNAL OF PHILOSOPHY invites articles, book/article reviews, critical discussions that disseminate a comprehensive idea about an issue having philosophical underpinning at its core, with lucidity and sound arguments that can reach a wider audience. The journal is chiefly concerned with philosophy; however, academics from other disciplines also are welcome to contribute to the journal provided their papers have philosophical value. The papers should be free from plagiarized content and should not be published elsewhere. The authors should submit a separate declaration in this regard. However, the manuscript will be checked by plagiarism detection software by the editorial board before being sent to the reviewers for evaluation.

The authors should prepare a manuscript for blind review. A separate file containing abstract/summary of the paper within 250 words along with 8-10 keywords and the author's institutional affiliation should be submitted. Another file should contain the main paper not exceeding 6000 words in case of original article, 4500 words in case of review and 3000 words

in case of critical discussion. The paper should have a title in Times New Roman font, 14-size, bold, center-positioned. The main paper should be in Times New Roman font, 12-size and justified. The sub-headings should be bold and 12-size. The Sanskrit terms should be given by using standard diacritical marks. APA 6th Edition should be used for Reference/Bibliography. Footnote should be avoided, instead in-text citation is preferred. Notes should be given at the end of the paper, for this purpose numbers should be put serially by using superscript instead of using the option “Insert Footnote/Insert Endnote”. Use single ‘tab’ instead of ‘space’ while starting a new paragraph.
